How much does a visit to the doctor cost?

New patient appointment are 90-110 minutes and cost \$350. Once you are a patient, all further patient consultations are follow up consultations. A typical follow up appointment lasts 30-60 minutes and costs \$180-\$240, however follow ups may be shorter or longer*.

What should I bring with me?

Recent medical tests, along with a list of your current prescription drugs or supplements you are taking. If you take many dietary supplements, we may ask you to bring them with you.

Initial Consultations at Synergy

A patient's first appointment is usually 90-100 minutes long, giving Dr Wicher time to develop a thorough understanding of you and your health concerns, and to put together a treatment plan you can start right away.

First appointments include:

- A medical history and physical exam
- Review of any recent tests, prescription drugs and nutritional supplements you may be taking
- Review of diet, daily routine and personal habits
- Discussion of the patient's goals and objectives
- A personal treatment plan you can start right away
- Referrals for labs and diagnostics as needed

Follow up visits are scheduled on an as needed basis to evaluate a patient's progress and adjust his or her treatment plan. These visits are typically 30-60 minutes, depending on the reason for and scope of the follow up.
